Both Abel and Juda died in 1836. According to a 1933 letter, Juda Kendrick died at the home of Henry H. Beall and Elizabeth Beall in Forsyth Co., GA, with whom she had lived since the death of her husband. Elizabeth was Juda and Abel's daughter.
