

John Cannon of Cass County & Tarrant County, Texas: Time Line

- 1841 Dec. **Republic of Texas.** John Cannon stated that he emigrated to Texas at this time.
- 1844 04 Nov. **Harrison Co., TX.** He stated that he was married and entitled to a conditional grant of 640 acres of land.
- 1845 30 Jul. **Harrison Co., TX.** John Cannon received 401-1/16<sup>th</sup> acres in Certificate 70.
- 1850 **Cass Co., TX.** John Canon, 66 [b c 1784], farmer, 640 acres, born in SC, with wife Pathana, 64, NC, married within the year were in the census with Louisa Canon, 15, born in NC [unclear if she was John's or "Pathana"'s daughter] Enumerated 09 Oct 1850.
- 1851 10 Dec. **Cass Co., TX.** John Cannon patented 401.16 acres, certificate 2, Patent 70, p. 8, Bowie 3<sup>rd</sup> Class, File 138. [Carter Cannon had 320 acres, certificate 334, patented 10 Dec 1851, Patent 69, p. 8, Bowie 3<sup>rd</sup> Class, File 135. Under certificate 334, Carter also had 320 acres, Patent 61, p. 13, 16 Jan 1856, File 135.]
- 1852 23 Dec. **Cass Co., TX.** John Cannon filed field notes on 239 acres.
- 1853 18 May. **Cass Co., TX.** John Cannon patented 239 acres, certificate 2, Patent 328, p. 7, Bowie 3<sup>rd</sup> Class, File 138.
- 1853 11 Nov. **Tarrant Co., TX.** John Cannon & wife Barthemy Cannon, now of Tarrant Co., sold his patent, 239 acres in Cass Co. on Cannon's Creek, tributary of Black Cypress, adjacent to land of Carter Cannon, to Hinton Duncan. Carter & Sarah Cannon sold to Hinton Duncan on the same date and also were of Tarrant Co.

- 1860 **Tarrant Co., TX.** Tax list: John Cannon. Was this the John Cannon who had been in Cass Co.? Was John Cannon of Cass & Tarrant counties the same man who had married Jemima Cantrell in Hall Co., GA, in 1824? Jemima lived until 1862 in Washington Co., AR. Did Jemima and John Cannon divorce?
