

Juda [maiden name unknown], Wife of Abel A. Kendrick

Some researchers have believed that **Juda** is **Judith Cannon**, daughter of **Jane (Campbell) and Russell Cannon**; however Juda was too old to have been their daughter. **Juda** was born about 1760, and **Russell Cannon** was born about 1753/1754, according to tax records, deeds, and censuses. **Kendrick** researchers have assumed that she was a **Cannon** because **Russell Cannon, Simcock's** son, had a daughter, **Judith**, who married a **Kendrick, Kendricks, Kindricks, or Kindrick – first name unknown**.

Abel Kendrick died 23 Aug 1836 in Hall Co., GA, at age 77. **Juda** died 28 Sep 1836, Forsyth Co., GA. **Abel Kendrick** was born 14 Mar 1759, in Hanover Co., VA, according to his pension record. His son, **Robert Kendrick**, appointed **F. E. Hasslar** of Washington City, D.C. as his attorney on 23 Nov 1852 in Cobb Co., Georgia, to obtain the pension of his father, **Abel Kendrick**, who had served in the Revolutionary War. He stated that his father died in August 1836 in Hall Co., GA, and that his mother, named **Juda Kendrick**, died a few weeks thereafter in the County of Forsyth, Georgia. After marriage, they resided in Union District, SC, and later came to Georgia. [Abel Kendrick applied for a pension, which he did not receive, 14 Mar 1834. He said that he and his wife came to Franklin Co., GA, about 1814 and to Hall Co., GA, about 1821. See http://members.tripod.com/~DINKINS_2/abel_kendrick.html.
